ROUTE 634 BRIDGE REPLACEMENT IN SURRY COUNTY COMPLETED

Bridge over Chippokes Creek reopened to all traffic

SURRY COUNTY – Crews with the Virginia Department of Transportation (VDOT) have completed the bridge replacement project on Route 634 (Highgate Road) over Chippokes Creek in Surry County and reopened the road to all traffic on June 3, 2020.

The bridge replacement project began last fall and involved removing and replacing the former 87-year-old bridge. The bridge project included many improvements such as adding a culvert with a new guardrail system, a widened shoulder on the approaching roadway for additional site distance, and additional roadway width at the creek crossing to allow for safe passage of two way traffic.
