NIGHTLY LANE CLOSURES COMING TO I-64 WEST AND BIG BETHEL ROAD DURING OVERPASS BRIDGE MAINTENANCE

HAMPTON - Starting as early as Friday, Jan. 24 and continuing until early next week, the Virginia Department of Transportation (VDOT) will begin bridge maintenance work on the Big Bethel Road overpass on I-64 in the City of Hampton, requiring nightly lane closures to allow crews to safely perform the bridge maintenance, while lessening the impact to the traveling public.

Motorists traveling on I-64 westbound will encounter single or double-lane closures nightly beginning after Hampton Roads Center Parkway (mile marker 262) through the Big Bethel Road overpass (mile marker 260.5), from 7 p.m. to 5 a.m.

The bridge maintenance will also require a single-lane closure southbound on Big Bethel Road nightly between the hours of 7 p.m. and 5 a.m.

All work is dependent on favorable weather conditions.

Motorists traveling through the area are encouraged to slow down and be mindful of VDOT crews.
